From the Pastor's Pen

The start of September brings the start of a new program year at StJLC.

We begin on day 1 with our new sermon series, "Knowing and Doing God's Will." It's based on Henry Blackaby's Experiencing God, a well-known Bible study from the '90s which had a profound impact on my life about 15 years ago. The book

changed the way I preach on Sundays and walk with the Lord throughout the week. I'm excited to share with you seven steps for discerning and following God's guidance for your life. The eightweek series begins with an overview on September 1, carries all the way through September, and ends in late October. During that time, I myself will be asking God to show me His will for our church over the next five years. What will you ask God to do in your life? How will you ask God to lead you? Join us on Sunday mornings as we discover God's guidance for our lives and for our church.

If you'd like to dig deeper, join me on **Wednesday evenings** in the Family Life Center for a longer look at each of the seven steps. Seven Realities for Experiencing God is a study Blackaby wrote for his book "to identify the biblical pattern by which God reveals His will so that you can join Him in His work." I'll lead a large-group presentation and discussion on each of the seven principles. The workbook includes daily devotions for further study and reflection. The seven-session

class begins September 4 and runs on Wednesday evenings, 6:30-7:30pm,

ending October 16. There is no need to sign up but bring \$15 for the materials.

If you feel like God is leading you to join our church, now is the time to do it! Our **New Members class** begins September 22. This five-week class will introduce you

to the Lutheran church and our discipleship pathway here at StJLC: "Worship Weekly, Walk Daily, Connect Consistently, Serve Monthly." We'll receive you into membership during worship services the sixth week, on October 27. The one-hour classes are offered on Sunday mornings, 9:30-10:30am, in Luther Hall (behind the Chapel). We expect a big class this Fall, so you'll need to sign up online or by Connect Card.

The month draws to a close September 29 with our **Annual Meeting** in the Sanctuary after the Late Service (approximately 12:15pm). Members of StJLC will gather to hear reports from the Council, pastors, and committees, to vote on the budget for next year, and to vote on proposed revisions to the church Constitution and Bylaws. Our Constitution does not allow voting by proxy, so you need to be there in person if you want your voice to be heard and your vote counted.
